Participants registered under the "International Course" category are expected to adhere to the following instructions:

 Registration and Selection: Eligible candidates are requested to register online through IIRS website https://isat.iirs.gov.in/isatcourse.php only on or before the last date mentioned in the course brochure. Candidates are advised to fill their correct and active e-mail address in the application form, and check regularly for the communication from the Institute. All correspondence will be made by the Institute through email only. No separate communication will be made.

Selection of participants will be done based on the documents submitted at the time of registration. Finally selected candidates will receive login credentials for the ISRO-IIRS Space Applications Training (ISAT) Programme via https://eclass-intl-lms.iirs.gov.in/login/index.php. Candidates are requested to check their email (inbox as well as spam).

- 2. **Mode of Training:** The programme will be conducted online through live and interactive sessions as per the course schedule available on E-CLASS portal. Participants should attend the sessions live via **E-CLASS portal** -https://eclass-intl.iirs.gov.in. Attendance of live sessions is mandatory which makes you eligible for awarding the course certificate.
