- Candidates are advised to reach the venue at least one hour before the exam so as to complete the registration formalities well before the time. No candidate, in any circumstances, will be allowed to enter the Examination Centre after the commencement of the exam.

- Candidates are requested to carry any valid photo identity proof (College ID Card, Driving License, Passport, Aadhaar Card, Voter Id, PAN Card) to the examination Centre.

- 6. Candidates are not allowed to bring rough paper into the exam hall. Blank paper will be provided for rough work in the exam hall. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the exam hall without handing over the rough sheet to the Invigilator concerned after the end of exam.
- Calculators, log tables, calculating devices, communication devices like cellular phone etc. and textual materials are not allowed in the Examination Centre. Violation of this will lead to cancellation of candidature.
